Annual NLCD

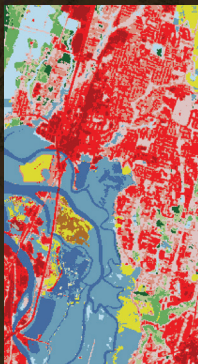
- Debuted in October 2024 as an improvement from legacy NLCD by providing a look at yearly changes going back to 1985
- Releases 16 classes of land cover information for the lower 48 states
- Relies on the long record of Landsat satellite data

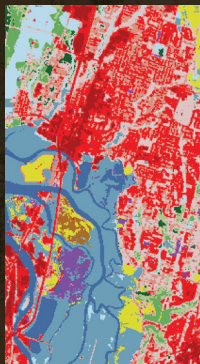

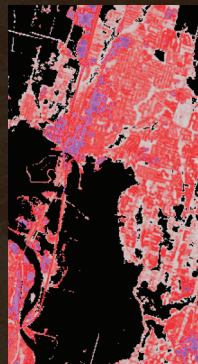

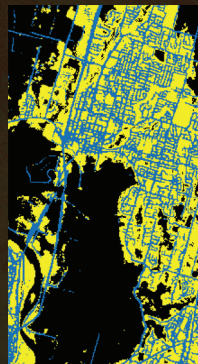

FRACTIONAL IMPERVIOUS SURFACE



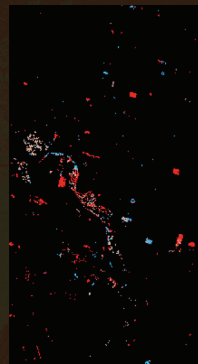
Amount of area
